WHAT MAKES 137 PILLARS SUITES & RESIDENCES BANGKOK UNIQUE?

It's simple: [137 Pillars Suites & Residences Bangkok](#) operates as both a glamorous hotel and functional residence, with 179 apartments and 34 suites. Each one is accompanied by expansive views of the city and furnished with opulent touches of modern-day conveniences and plush furnishings, including a sleek marble bathroom with a standing tub and shower, private balconies, and full kitchenettes. Suite-staying guests can enjoy additional butler services and access to the Baan Borneo lounge.

Rooted in the heart of the Sukhumvit-Phrom Phong district of Bangkok, the property reflects the location's charm as a destination of business and lifestyle. Just moments away from the glitz and glam of premium shopping districts, Michelin-star restaurants, and seamless transport connectivity, it manages to capture the private intimacy of a boutique stay—from thoughtful touches of an astute hospitality team to the familiar comforts of lived-in interiors.

This curated sense of hospitality began with 137 Pillars House Chiang Mai, revived from Borneo House, an historic teak homestead that originated in the late 19th century. Meticulously preserved with careful thought in honoring the property history as the Borneo Trading Company, the exclusive 30-suite oasis has risen to be a beloved luxury flagship within the wider 173 Pillars Hotel & Resort portfolio.

WHAT CAN GUESTS EXPECT?

Similar commitment to tradition, heritage, and details has been woven into the Bangkok outpost, starting with immersive comforts that wash away the clamors of daily life. A dramatic infinity pool hangs over the 33rd-floor rooftop (reserved for suites guests only) and beckons with a glistening sea of blue for a rejuvenating moment in the clouds (a second pool is located on the 27th floor for both suites and serviced residences guests). All can enjoy the [Nitra Serenity Centre](#), a restorative sanctuary of holistic rituals, led by the 7 Pillars of Wellness philosophy.

A slower pace of city-living is what defines each stay at [137 Pillars Suites & Residences Bangkok](#); breakfast for suites for example, is served until 5 p.m. and until 2 p.m. for serviced residences. Guests are invited to pause to take in the daily sinking sunset at [Nimitr](#), which serves hearty flavors of modern Thai cuisine, prepared with seasonal ingredients, herbs, and species harvested from the property's own farm. Elsewhere, [Bangkok Trading Post](#) presents comfort bistro-style dishes for casual afternoons and bites for leisurely in-between moments, while cocktails at resident speakeasy [Jack Bain's Bar](#) ease into fully relaxed evenings with invigorating Thai-meets-British flavors.

Step up a gear with the property's unique experiences that showcase the city's fast-moving dynamism. The Louie Tour, named after Louis Leonowens, the original owner of the Borneo Trading company, is a full-day exploration. Travel through Bangkok's iconic sites and *sois* (neighborhoods) of hidden cultural landmarks, fully encapsulating the brand's ethos of luxury hospitality and heritage.
